<p>Draw a picture that shows Samuel at one side of the page <i>growing</i> coffee and a teacher on the opposite side of the page <i>drinking</i> coffee!</p> <p>How are the two people connected?</p> <p>Draw the journey that coffee takes from Samuel to the teacher.</p>	<p>Create a coffee painting. Ask a grown up to make a small amount of coffee.</p> <p>Use a paint brush to paint a picture of a coffee plant.</p> <p>Send a picture of your artwork to Teams, or the Fairtrade Schools team at schools@fairtrade.org.uk.</p>	<p>Create your own 2-minute documentary showing where you live and what you do at home every day.</p>

(you can click on the video to drag the picture and get a 360° view).</p> <p>When you go outside today, close your eyes for 20 seconds and listen to all of sounds you can hear.</p> <p>Hold up a fist. Every time you hear a sound, raise a finger.
