School Admissions 2024/25:

The school is currently accepting applications for admissions into Junior Infants 2024/2025. Forms are available from the School Office and from the school website under the Admissions tab. It is the parent(s)/guardian(s) responsibility to ensure they receive and return the Enrolment Application Form by Friday 23rd of February at 2pm. The completion and submission of an Application Form, or the placement of your child's name on a list, however early, does not confer an automatic right of place in the school. We will follow the Admissions Policy and the Annual Admission Notice 2024/25 which are available on the school website.
